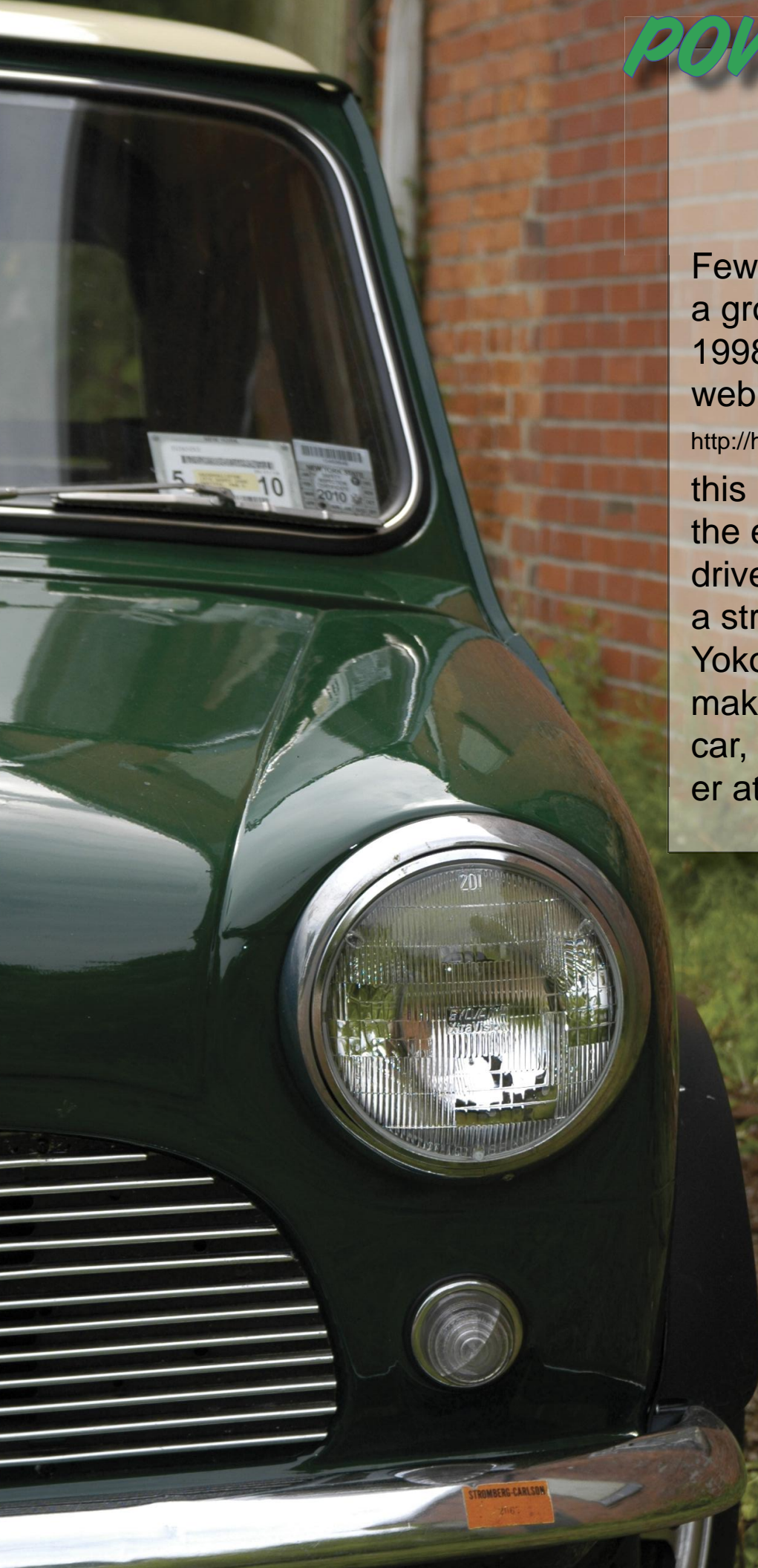


POWER SPEED GREEN

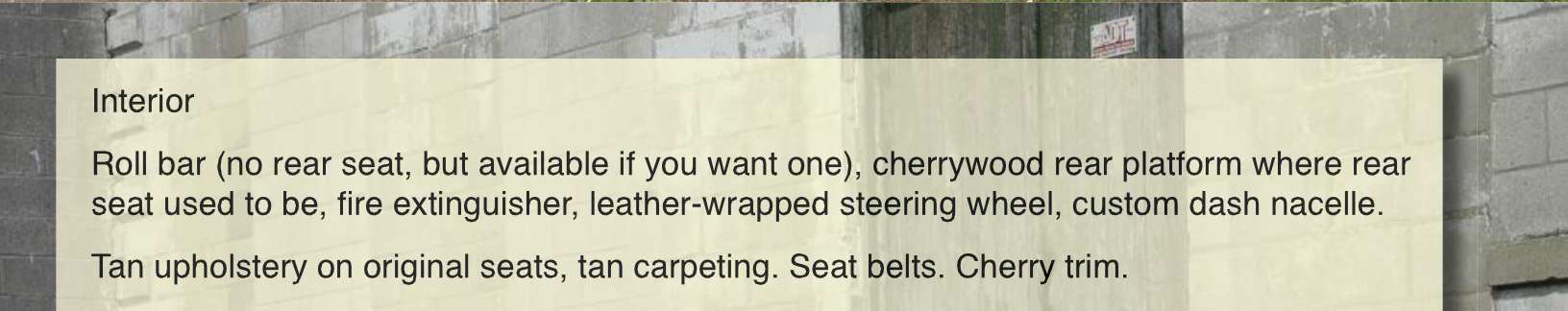




Mechanical

998 Cooper engine, disk brakes, 5 inch A100 wheels fitted with Yokohama A008 tires, fiberglass flip front, new wiring harness.

No rust, never driven in winter or rain since restoration.



Interior

Roll bar (no rear seat, but available if you want one), cherrywood rear platform where rear seat used to be, fire extinguisher, leather-wrapped steering wheel, custom dash nacelle.

Tan upholstery on original seats, tan carpeting. Seat belts. Cherry trim.
